PALESTINE

Gaza Facts & Figures Since the Beginning of the Invasion on 28 June 2006 until 07 August

- Palestinians killed between 28 June–07 August: 186
- Palestinians injured between 28 June–07 August: 771
- During last Israeli military operation in the As Shoka area, 17 Palestinians were killed, including 5 children and 34 were injured
- The total death in the Occupied Palestinian Territories currently stands at 203 of which 17 occurred in the West Bank
- 42 Children were killed by the Israeli Occupying Force since the beginning of the Summer Rain Operation
- 15 houses destroyed by IOF warplanes following prior phone call warnings
- Israelis killed between 28 June–07 August: 2, including 1 soldier killed by friendly fire in the Gaza Strip
- 25 Israelis injured in the Occupied Palestinian Territories
- Israeli soldiers captured: 1 in Gaza Strip
- 9850 Palestinian prisoners currently in Israeli jails
- More than 3,400 Palestinians sought shelter in UNRWA buildings because of the Israeli incursions
- Artillery shells fired by Israeli tanks: 200-250 per day
- At least 190 air-to-surface missiles launched by Israeli Occupying Force
- Air strikes conducted by Israel, 28 June-07 August: 246
- Homemade 'rockets' fired by Palestinians towards Israel: 8 per day

LEBANON

Toll of a war that shames the world

On 9th August 2006, 28 days since Hizbollah captured two Israeli soldiers, 932 people have been killed in Lebanon, with 75 missing, presumed dead.

- 29 Lebanese Army soldiers have been killed
- 3,293 Lebanese civilians have been wounded
- 45 per cent of the casualties have been children
- 915,792 Lebanese people have been displaced (300,000 of whom are children), including 220,000 Lebanese who fled the country
- 94 Israelis have been killed and 1,867 wounded
- 10,000 Israeli soldiers are currently fighting Hizbollah in southern Lebanon
- 3,000 rockets have been fired at Israel by Hizbollah
- The average number of rockets fired daily by Hizbollah in the first week of the conflict was 90. Over the past five days, it has been 169
- 4 United Nations observers and one member of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL) have been killed
